## **Button Functions**

#### T9 Watch



Power button

Long press:

Watch Mode (power ON/OFF) Golf Mode (end the mode)

Short press:

backlight ON



The small hole on the top of the watch is not a reset button.

How to reset: press and hold for 10 seconds to restart.

## Shot & putt indicator



#### Shot indicator

 Recognizes and displays automatic/ manual shots in a hole during a round

#### **Putt indicator**

- Recognizes and displays automatic/ manual putts in a hole during a round

e.g., tee shot



e.g., 7 shots and 5 putts



## **Screen Description**

## How to change watch face





- · Touch and hold on the watch face to enter the watch face setting screen
- · Change watch face with touch slide to left and right
- · Touch the dot at the top of the screen to change color
- · When setting is complete, touch the V at the bottom of the screen

## Time / Date Settings

#### Automatic setting (outdoor only)



When Golf Mode is selected Time is automatically set after GPS signal is received

## Manual setting (indoor/outdoor possible)

▶ On the Menu screen, touch 🍪 > touch 'Time'





Touch 'Current Time' in the list to enter, then swipe up and down to set the time

▶ On the Menu screen, touch ② > touch 'Time'






Touch 'Date' in the list to enter, then swipe up and down to set the date



#### What is V.AI™?

An Al-based golf service that automatically provides necessary information by detecting the golfer's location and situation so that the golfer can focus on his or her swing during a round.

e.g., teeing area, entering fairway after tee shot, entering green attack area, on green



Shot Feedback View - detects a shot and displays distance and tempo Shot & Putt Indicator - automatically detects and displays shots & putts

## **Enter Golf Mode**

· When the 'Golf Mode' icon is touched, it received GPS signal before it automatically detects a hole



# Switch to the 'Course View, Green View, Yardage View' screen

· When running Golf Mode for the first time, swipe the 'Course View' screen to enter Green View, Putt View, and Yardage View




Course View, Green View, Putt View images may vary with regions and golf course situations.

 $\frak{\%}$  'Yardage View' displays key data in large numbers when the + button icon is tapped



- · If you touch the 'Course Preview' icon > at the teeing area, the device will play 'Course Preview'.
- It shows the distance to a bunker close to where the tee shot lands

Once the playback is finished, the screen returns to Golf Mode
\* If the screen is touched during playback, it immediately returns to Golf Mode



HDCP / IP / Driver Distance
It shows information on
bunkers and hazards


It shows distance to the pin



#### **Real Green Undulation**

It indicates in 11 stages, using the actually measured green undulation data

Green Zoom (2-stage)
 When the icon is touched,
 the green is expanded ('Pin Reload' is supported)



Green Zoom (2-stage)

X Touch the icon once: Stage 1, twice: Stage 2



· The shape of the green automatically rotates as the golfer's location changes





 It shows the height and distance from the ball to the pin








- **Default use**: When a spot on the green is touched, the ball moves and the distance to the pin is provided
- · When APL is active: When you move to where the ball lies and touches the ball icon ( ), information is provided
- · When APL is not active:
  - 1 Move to where the ball lies and touches the ball icon ( ).
  - ② Return to where the pin lies and touch the pin icon ( ), and height and distance are provided.
- · Zoom in or out with the +/- tap. You can toggle between screens by dragging on the expanded screen



## Indication of Bunkers / Hazards

· It indicates the distance to the front or rear of bunkers / hazards

Touch a specific bunker or hazard



\* Touch on the enlarged screen is easier

## **Shot Feedback View**

· Shot Tempo: automatically provides the swing tempo of the shot immediately before a shot just taken



Automatically provides backswing, downswing, and tempo by detecting the golfer's swing

· Golf ball distance: When the icon is touched, the distance and tempo of the previous shot are shown.



Touch the **SHOT** icon or the distance number icon to see distance and shot tempo


You can measure the distance manuall by touching the icon

## **Tempo Practice Mode**

#### What is tempo practice mode?

A mode that provides practice in timing the tempo by setting a target tempo, so that you can practice for a consistent swing.


On the menu screen, touch >
 Choose from among 'Full Swing, Approach, and Putt"




## **Tempo Practice Mode**

#### 2 ways to set target tempo

· Amidst the Tempo Mode items, touch 'Target Tempo' > Choose from among 'Full Swing, Approach, and Putt'



· Touch and hold the center of the screen in Tempo Mode



When setting the Target Tempo, the target speed is displayed as a color circle.- Fast (Red), Accurate (Blue), Slow (Yellow)



## APL (auto pin location)?

The function that automatically updates real-time pin positions in T9

- However, syncing with the 'My Voice Caddie' app is required
   (see the website for a list of supported golf courses)
  - \* All smartphones are supported, regardless of their carrier.
- · APL alert
  Real-time pin location notification pop-up is provided (once) only at the initial reception

- 1. Search "My Voice Caddie" in the app search screen
- 2. Download and execute the app
- 3. When executing the app, log in for the first time or sign up for membership
- 4. Touch Connect on the home screen
- 5. After activating Bluetooth on the device, enter the security number displayed on the device into the app to connect

## **App Connection**

#### **Bluetooth Activation**



① Swipe down the watch face



② Touch 'Connect' to activate Bluetooth



③ Check the identification number of T9




 After checking the security number displayed on the device when connecting to the app, enter it into the app

<sup>\*</sup> An interworked app brings features including phone, text message, Social media reception, Tempo Practice Mode, APL (Pin here & now), quick GPS, score management, updated golf course information, and firmware download

## How to Connect APL in the App

#### Simple Mode (only for Android)

 Touch 'Start APL' on the login screen
 It can be used right away; login not necessary



Bluetooth, location authorization, and allow service notification need to be set up

## How to Connect after Logging in (for Android and iOS)

- ① Touch the watch image or 'MY VC'( ) at the bottom of the main screen
- ② Execute 'APL Golf Mode' from the menu
- ※ APL use requires the authorization of service notification and consent to location service.
